



#### **Research Study and Methodology**

**Data Collection: (Primary Data & Secondary Data)** 

#### **Primary Data:**

- i. **Quantitative Data Collection:** The field team utilized a prepared questionnaire and conducted data collection via telephone. The data collection process by field investigators was closely monitored by an expert team to uphold the quality and accuracy of the data.
- ii. Qualitative Data Collection: Interview sessions were conducted with various stakeholders including the Vice Chancellor of the University, Directors of three Schools, and Professors from all three Schools. Data were gathered using a prescribed questionnaire during these sessions.

#### **Secondary Data:**

The secondary data collection process involves gathering information from various sources such as the official websites of JK Paper and the university, magazines, annual reports, and CSR reports. By accessing these sources, researchers can gather relevant information about JK Paper's activities, initiatives, and contributions, as well as insights into the university's operations, achievements, and impact. Additionally, information obtained from magazines and CSR reports provides valuable context and background information to enrich the analysis.

#### **Research Tools:**

Physical interviews and focus group discussions were scheduled to engage with scholarship recipients. Additionally, comprehensive discussions were conducted with the Vice Chancellor, Chief Financial Officer (CFO), Head- Student Affairs, Head- Training & Placement and CEO-AIC-JKLU academicians, and other stakeholders associated with JKLU. Pertinent information was gathered from these stakeholders through the utilization of various methods.

#### **Data Analysis:**

### i. Desktop Review:

- Gender & Age: Among the 367 students who were awarded scholarships, gender distribution revealed that 41% were female recipients, a significant improvement from previous years. This gender breakdown underscores the diverse representation within the scholarship program. Furthermore, the scholars within this group shared a common age range, specifically falling between 19 and 21 years old.
- **Distribution of Scholarships Among Student:** Among 367 students, the dispersion of scholarship amounts showed notable diversity. A significant proportion—38% of the total—obtained scholarships ranging from Rs 50,000 to Rs 100,000. Additionally, a notable 21% received scholarships exceeding Rs 100,000. This distribution highlights the wide range of scholarship amounts disbursed among the students.
- Scholarship Distribution Including Hostel Support: A fraction totaling 11% of the students are recipients not only of academic scholarships but also benefit from additional support in the form of hostel scholarships.

It has been observed in focus group discussions that winning a competitive scholarship demonstrates their academic excellence, leadership skills, and other qualities that will help them to impress future employers and academic institutions.

Scholarships offered crucial financial assistance to students, serving as a lifeline in funding their educational pursuits. Also, scholarship opens doors to new experiences and ignited a passion for continuous learning, setting them on a path of endless possibilities.

#### Limitations of the assessment:

• Limited sample size or low response rates from questionnaires/surveys affect data reliability and generalizability. We have interviewed 70+ students out of 367 beneficial students which constitute approx 20 percent of total sample size.

- Difficulty in identifying and engaging with all relevant stakeholders may lead to gaps in understanding perspectives and impacts. We have also conducted focus group discussions with few academicians and administrative staff to understand complete ecosystem of university.
- Some respondents skip questions, leading to incomplete data and potential bias. To address this, we conducted unstructured interviews with all responded beneficiaries.


#### **Aligned Theory of Change:**



The number of students benefiting from the scholarship program across the three institutes under JKLU.






The scholarship amount distributed in CSR activities by JK Paper Limited across three institutes within JKLU.

#### 1. Introduction

The rural entrepreneurship programme is a pioneering intervention under the Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiative of JK Paper Ltd. in Rayagada, Odisha. This initiative targets youth and budding entrepreneurs to ensure they utilize market opportunities and become self-reliant. The programme adopts a multipronged approach, providing training, seed support, facilitative access to finance, and links to government schemes. The goal is to empower targeted youth with the skills and support needed to thrive.

In 2022-23, the project covered 514 youths, offering training, financial support, and mentoring. The project not only provided initial support and training but also facilitated seed capital and connections to government schemes, enhancing opportunities for the participants. Furthermore, the project offered continuous mentoring and technical support to ensure the sustainability of the new enterprises.

# 2. Objectives of the Report

This report aims to present an in-depth analysis of the outcomes and impacts achieved by the JK Paper Youth Entrepreneurship Development Programme in the Rayagada district, covering seven blocks: Rayagada, Kalayansighpur, Kolnara, Gunupur, Padmapur, Ramnaguda, and Bissamcuttack.

# 3. Methodology

The assessment employed a telephonic cross-sectional survey design, conducted by NPRDA, to evaluate the effectiveness of the intervention. A random sample of 20 beneficiaries was selected from the detailed list of participants. The survey focused on several key areas:

- **Engagement Process:** Understanding the process through which participants engaged with the program.
- **Participation and Training:** Assessing the levels of participation and the effectiveness of the training provided.
- **Enterprise Finance:** Evaluating the financial aspects of the enterprises, including access to loans and seed capital.
- **Mentoring and Support:** Analyzing the support and mentoring received by the entrepreneurs.

# 4. Key Outcomes

# 4.1 Awareness and Training:

- Awareness Campaigns: The program raised entrepreneurship awareness among nearly 53,000 youths through various initiatives, including posters, banners, hoardings, and street plays across seven blocks. Participation in local exhibitions like the Chaiti Festival and JK Paper Durga Puja Festival, as well as regional and national events in Odisha and Delhi, further amplified the outreach.
- Counseling and Training: Over 14,700 youths were counseled, and nearly 3,500 were trained in various aspects of entrepreneurship. The training covered essential skills needed to start and manage a business, including business planning, financial management, and market analysis.

# **4.2 Entrepreneur Support:**

- Direct Support and Mentoring: 514 entrepreneurs received direct support and mentoring. This included providing seed capital, facilitating bank loans, and offering continuous business advisory services.
- Financial Facilitation: The program facilitated bank loans worth Rs. 11.93

crores to support the entrepreneurs' financial needs. These loans were critical in helping the startups and struggling businesses to scale and sustain their operations.

 Network of Mentors: A group of 560 mentors was trained and accredited to provide ongoing guidance and support to the young entrepreneurs. These mentors played a crucial role in the success of the program by offering their expertise and experience to help the entrepreneurs navigate challenges.

# **4.3 Entrepreneurial Achievements:**

# **Demographic Distribution:**

- Total Entrepreneurs Supported: 514
- Gender Distribution: 379 males and 135 females.
- Community Background: Scheduled Caste (SC) 60, Scheduled Tribe (ST) -50, Other Backward Classes (OBC) - 192, General - 212.

#### **Financial Achievements:**

- Loans Disbursed: A total of Rs. 11.93 crore was disbursed in loans, with an average loan size of Rs. 2.32 lakhs.
- Types of Businesses: The supported businesses included 106 startups and 408 struggling startups that received assistance to become sustainable.
- Business Sectors: The businesses spanned various sectors, including Manufacturing (43), Retail/Trade (151), and Services (320).


